Description:

The Third Eye Chakra is the only one that moves, this is due to the movement of the Earth's axis. The Third Eye Chakra moves every 150-200 years or every aeon. These aeons are also lined up with astrological constellations. In 2012 we shifted into the Age of Aquarius, which means the Third Eye chakra is currently located in Western Europe near Stonehenge.
